When my HS saw me on Dec 31 2016 at the shelter I was cowering in my litterbox with my back to everyone shaking in fear. I had been renamed Burrito. The shelter was running a "special" on me - I was free as a barn cat. My silly unprepared human didn't even have a kennel with her that day. As the paperwork was being filled out it was "discovered" I had a fever. They tried to convince my HS to adopt another or to allow them to "keep me" a while longer. My HS knew that only meant I would never leave the shelter. So she said "I'll take her to the emergency vet on my way home.". It was a 3 hr drive home and I was never ill I was stressed. I went home in a cardboard box but my human went shopping and bought everything I needed and more. Once we got home my wonderful human put me in her room with her and allowed me time to heal. She didn't see me for almost a month out from under the bed but knew I was coming out to eat drink and use the litter box. The nighttime's are hardest for my human and each night



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without her knowing I was coming up on her bed protecting her and sending my calm purrs her way. My HS knew I was sleeping on the very foot of the bed because of the warm spot I would leave. One morning she woke up before I had a chance to leave and smiled for the first time in a long time. That night as I watched her she didn't have as many night terrors or tears. Slowly I got more brave and each time I would move up toward the head of the bed I noticed my HS did better day and night. Now I sleep curled up at chest level each night, only when bedded do I sleep in her pillow. I have been with my human 16 months and it gets better for both of us each day. Each time her weariness returns I increase my gentle calm presence. In Aug of 2017 she "fostered". HAHA FOSTERED my icky grubby brother Patrick. I knew she was a hopelessly wrapped around his paw too. We have an abundance of toys, bunkbeds, and love.
